Englemere DFAS Young Arts is pleased to introduce an award to support young artists to develop their skills and/or interest in the decorative and fine arts. The winner will receive £500 towards their studies, travel or materials, the runner up will receive an award of £250.

The award will be for young people studying the decorative and fine arts including visual arts and crafts. Closing date is 28th April 2012.

Eligibility

- aged 20 or younger at the time of application
- currently attending a school or College in the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead or Bracknell Forest studying art at 'A' level or a similar course leading to a formal qualification
- permanent home is within the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead or Bracknell Forest who has been accepted for a course of study leading to a recognised qualification in the arts
- students in their first year of study for a recognised qualification in the arts whose permanent home is within the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead or Bracknell Forest.

Entries

A CD-Rom containing 5-10 images of your work.

A supporting statement saying why you have chosen the course you have been selected for or are taking; what you hope to achieve from it; how you would see the award helping you in your studies; where you see yourself in five years time.

A supporting statement from the School or College where study is currently taking place.

Judging will take place during May and short listed candidates might be invited to an interview to take place at the end of May or early June. The Winners will be announced in June and they will be invited to an Award Presentation on Tuesday 10th July 2012.

The winners will be invited to make a short presentation to the Englemere Society this may take the form of a talk about their studies or a display of their work to show how the award helped them to advance their interests in the arts.

The Judging Panel will include and a local art professional and the Chairman, Young Arts Representative and at least 1 member of EDFAS.
